Certificate in Cyber Law Awareness for Netizens is a Course meant to provide an understanding of the basic structure of Cyber Laws and its impact on the common man in the Cyber Era.

At the end of the Course, the student would be aware of the nature of the Nature and Scope of Cyber Laws, Nature of Cyber Properties, Essence of Cyber Contracts, Using of Digital Signatures, Law regarding Common Cyber Crimes, etc. They will also be familiar with the objectives and key features of Information Technology Act 2000.

Since the Course is meant for the common man, emphasis would be given to simple language and explanation of concepts in the context of the environment in which a common man uses computers either at home or in an office or a Cyber cafe.

Who should take this course?

This course is meant for any person who uses computers and Internet. No prior knowledge of either law or technology is required.
